Lunch and afternoon programme will take place as usual.

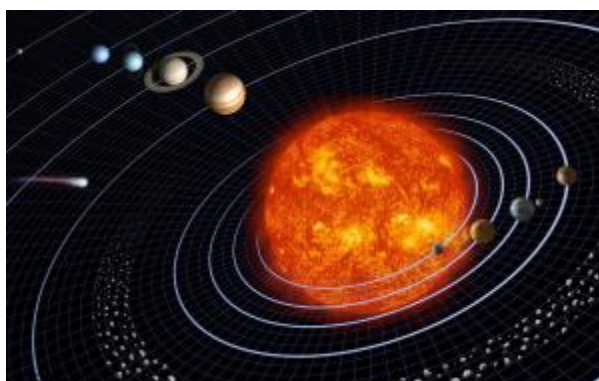

LITERARY COMPETITION

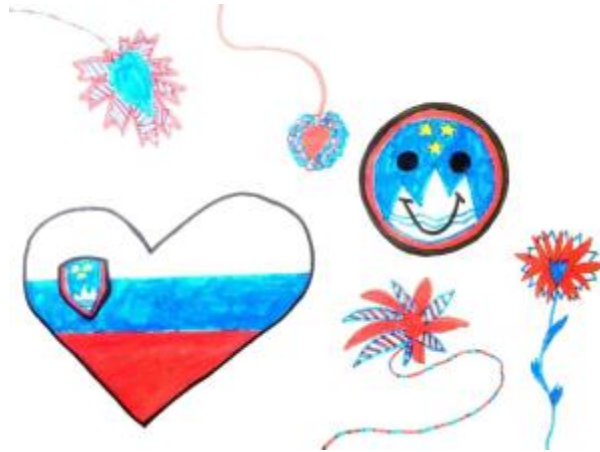
