ENGLISH LANGUAGE COMPETITION - MYP 2 (7M)


This year our **MYP 2** students can take part in the English language competition organised by the National Education Institute Slovenia. Students will first participate in the school round and the best students then qualify for the national round.

Students will have to demonstrate their knowledge in the following areas:


School round: reading comprehension, use of language (grammar and vocabulary), written task.
