Dear students and parents.


For all the students who applied, The Kangaroo Mathematics competition will be held on Thursday, **16 March**. The competition will be organised in school starting:

3km RUN FOR GROUPS OF THREE – MYP

On Saturday, May 6, 2023, there will be a 3km run for primary schools in Ljubljana, with applicants competing in groups of three. The students who want to compete will need to give a completed and signed application form to the PHE teachers or homeroom teachers. The school will make the application for the contest for them, but the parents are obliged to bring the students to the event, get their race numbers, and then be responsible for them to getting to the starting point. More details of the competition follow below.

2. WHEN Saturday, **May 6, 2023**, starting at 09:10

3. APPLICATIONS

Applications are possible until **April 17, 2023**. Complete the application form that will be given to the student at PHE lessons and bring it back to the homeroom teacher or PHE teacher.

4. COMPETITION CATEGORIES

M1 - students born in 2008 and junior

Z1 - schoolgirls, born in 2008 and juniors

MZ1 - mixed triplet (by gender)

5. SCHEDULE OF STARTS

M1 - students born in 2008 in Jr. at 09:10

Z1 - schoolgirls, born in 2008 in Jr. at 09:10

MZ1 - mixed triples at 09:10

6. RIGHT OF APPEARANCE

All competitors who are primary school students of the same school and are regularly enrolled have the right to participate in the run for primary schools.

7. TRANSPORTATION TO THE STARTTransportation of the competitors for the 3 km Run to the Oskar Kovačič Elementary School (at Dolenjski železnici) will be by buses of the Ljubljana Passenger Transport Service. The last bus will depart at 08:00 from the Drama bus stop on Slovenska cesta in the direction of Trnovo.

8. GENERAL PROVISIONSThe trio must run the entire route (from start to finish) together, and only members of the SAME trio can provide assistance. Incomplete trios will be disqualified. The costs of participation are covered by the schools that register the teams, and the organisation of the competition is covered by the Municipality of Ljubljana.

Starting numbers and chips will be picked up on Thursday, May 4 and Friday, May 5 from 13:00 to 19:00 and on Saturday, May 6 between 07:00 and 08: 00 at Trg republike. At the start, the male and female competitors will hand in their sports equipment in bags, which will be transported to the changing room tent on Trg republike. The organiser does not guarantee the sports equipment handed out at the start! The starting point will be in the carpark of the Oskar Kovačič Elementary School, at Dolenjski železnici 48 and the finish line will be at Kongresni trg. Kind regards,
